CONTRACT LIQUOR AND CANNABIS INSPECTORS

Cambridge Bay, Iqaluit and Rankin Inlet

Liquor and cannabis inspectors are needed on a contractual basis in Cambridge Bay, Iqaluit and Rankin Inlet to ensure licensed premises and special occasion permit holders comply with the provisions of the *Nunavut Liquor Act*, *Cannabis Act* and *Regulations*.

Experience in enforcement along with the ability to interpret acts and regulations would be considered an asset. You must have good written and oral communication skills. Weekends and late evening inspections are done on an as-needed basis.

Successful candidates must submit to a criminal record check and provide their own transportation. Training will be provided.

Priority will be given to Nunavut Inuit. Candidates must clearly identify their eligibility to receive priority consideration under the Nunavut Priority Hiring Policy.
