Topic:Adult Correctional Services2017/2018Released by Statistics Canada – May 9, 2019

Background: In 2017/2018, the total number of adult admissions to custodial services in Nunavut was **982**, **up** by **10.3%** from 2016/2017. Community Admissions were **900**, **up** by **0.3%** from the previous year. Also, **185** adults received probation and conditional sentences, which **increased** by **43.4%**.

 option programs, bail supervision and restitution orders. Due to limitations and differences among jurisdictional programs,
 inter-jurisdictional comparisons of the data should be made with caution
