In accordance with the policies outlined within Education Staff Regulations and the Nunavut Educator Qualifications Service (NECS) policies, Teaching Certificates are issued for a period of five (5) years. The Registrar for Teacher Certification may renew the teaching certificate if the holder has met the requirements for recertification. NECS has set the requirements for certification as: "During the five year period that the certificate is valid, a holder of a teaching certificate must participate in a minimum of 120 hours of professional development. These activities will be recorded in a log, verified by the principal or appropriate supervisor, and submitted with the application for recertification.
