

FANS APPLICATION PROCESS

1. APPLICATION



Download and complete the Application for Financial Assistance for Nunavut Students form at: <http://www.gov.nu.ca>

2. SUBMISSION



Send signed application form and all supporting documentation to: FANS@gov.nu.ca
****All applications are immediately date stamped***

3. ASSESSMENT



Applications are assessed based on the following criteria:

- ✓ Residency;
- ✓ Suspension;
- ✓ Program eligibility;
- ✓ Designated school

****All applications are reviewed within 2 business days of receipt***

4. GRANT/LOAN ELIGIBILITY



Beneficiaries:

- *Basic Grant* of up to \$6,855/year for tuition and airfare;
- *Supplementary Grant* of up to \$2,850/month for living expenses;
- *Needs assessed Loan* of up to \$165/week while in school

Non- Beneficiaries:

- One year of the *Basic Grant* for each three years of schooling completed in Nunavut;
- *Primary OR Secondary Loan* of up to \$5,200;
- *Needs assessed Loan* of up to \$165/week while in school

5. NOTIFICATION



- Students receive notification of approval or denial within the same business day by email if application is fully complete (NO missing information).

****For incomplete applications- students receive immediate notification by email of missing information. Letters are sent within 2 business days***

6. TRAVEL



Students eligible for the Basic Grant receive travel benefits. Students are responsible for making their own travel arrangements and submitting copies to Fanstravel@gov.nu.ca

7. PAYMENT



Once at school, students submit their completed Student Enrolment Form to FANS. Payments are direct deposited into students' bank accounts. 70% of the funding is deposited on the 1st of the month and the remaining 30% on the 15th

Every application is handled on an individual basis. No standard timelines can be applied to this as it depends on the information that the applicant has submitted/or not submitted.
